### ESSAY TOPIC

Recent research indicates that a majority of graduate students admit to cheating in one way or another, such as copying the work of another person, using cheat sheets in class, or using smart phones during exams. While cheating may seem to provide an easy and quick way to high grades, it certainly interferes negatively with the quality of the education that learners receive and will impact their future in undesirable and inefficient ways.

#### **Assignment:**

In an argumentative essay of about 400 words, identify the causes of the phenomenon, discuss the consequences of developing cheating habits on the learner's future education and career and on society as a whole, and suggest possible solutions.

Your essay will be evaluated according to the following criteria:

- Content (comprehensiveness and relevancy)
- Organization (cohesion and coherence)
- Language
- Mechanics
- Clarity of handwriting
